

Sins Which Exclude One From The Kingdom of God

1 Corinthians 6:9-10

“Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.”

Unrighteous – 94 - ä' -dē-kos – “descriptive of one who violates or has violated justice” - unjust

Fornicators – 4205 - po'r-nos – “a man who prostitutes his body to another's lust for hire”

Idolaters – 1496 - āi-dō-lo-lä'-trās – “a worshipper of false gods, an idolater”

Adulterers – 3432 - moi-kho's – “an adulterer”

Homosexuals – 3120 - mä-lä-ko's – “effeminate, of a male who submits his body to unnatural lewdness”

Sodomites – 733 - är-se-no-koi'-tās – “one who lies with a male as with a female, sodomite, homosexual”

Thieves – 2812 - kle'p-tās – “an embezzler, pilferer”

Covetous – 4123 - ple-o-ne'k-tās – “one eager to have more, esp. what belongs to others”

Drunkards – 3183 - me'-thü-sos – “drunken, intoxicated”

Revilers – 3060 - loi'-do-ros – “a railer, reviler” – “used of *injuring* another's reputation by denigrating, abusive insults”

Extortioners – 727 - hä'r-päks – “an extortioner, a robber”
