

Strong's Number **H7676** matches the Hebrew שַׁבָּת (*shabbath*), which occurs 108 times in **89** verses in the Hebrew concordance of the KJV

[Exo 16:23](#) And he said unto them, This *is that* which the LORD hath said, To morrow *is* the rest of the holy sabbath [H7676](#) unto the LORD: bake *that* which ye will bake *to day*, and seethe that ye will seethe; and that which remaineth over lay up for you to be kept until the morning.

[Exo 16:25](#) And Moses said, Eat that to day; for to day *is* a sabbath [H7676](#) unto the LORD: to day ye shall not find it in the field.

[Exo 16:26](#) Six days ye shall gather it; but on the seventh day, *which is* the sabbath, [H7676](#) in it there shall be none.

[Exo 16:29](#) See, for that the LORD hath given you the sabbath, [H7676](#) therefore he giveth you on the sixth day the bread of two days; abide ye every man in his place, let no man go out of his place on the seventh day.

[Exo 20:8](#) Remember the sabbath [H7676](#) day, to keep it holy.

[Exo 20:10](#) But the seventh day *is* the sabbath [H7676](#) of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates:

[Exo 20:11](#) For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath [H7676](#) day, and hallowed it.

[Exo 31:13](#) Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths [H7676](#) ye shall keep: for it *is* a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that *ye* may know that I *am* the LORD that doth sanctify you.

[Exo 31:14](#) Ye shall keep the sabbath [H7676](#) therefore; for it *is* holy unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth *any* work therein, that soul shall be cut off from among his people.

[Exo 31:15](#) Six days may work be done; but in the seventh *is* the sabbath [H7676](#) of rest, holy to the LORD: whosoever doeth *any* work in the sabbath [H7676](#) day, he shall surely be put to death.

[Exo 31:16](#) Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, [H7676](#) to observe the sabbath [H7676](#) throughout their generations, *for* a perpetual covenant.

[Exo 35:2](#) Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be to you an holy day, a sabbath [H7676](#) of rest to the LORD: whosoever doeth work therein shall be put to death.

[Exo 35:3](#) Ye shall kindle no fire throughout your habitations upon the sabbath [H7676](#) day.

[Lev 16:31](#) It *shall be* a sabbath [H7676](#) of rest unto you, and ye shall afflict your souls, by a statute for ever.

[Lev 19:3](#) Ye shall fear every man his mother, and his father, and keep my sabbaths: [H7676](#) I *am* the LORD your God.

[Lev 19:30](#) Ye shall keep my sabbaths, [H7676](#) and reverence my sanctuary: I *am* the LORD.

[Lev 23:3](#) Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day *is* the sabbath [H7676](#) of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work *therein*: it *is* the sabbath [H7676](#) of the LORD in all your

dwellings.

[Lev 23:11](#) And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath [H7676](#) the priest shall wave it.

[Lev 23:15](#) And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, [H7676](#) from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths [H7676](#) shall be complete:

[Lev 23:16](#) Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath [H7676](#) shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

[Lev 23:32](#) It *shall be* unto you a sabbath [H7676](#) of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth *day* of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath. [H7676](#)

[Lev 23:38](#) Beside the sabbaths [H7676](#) of the LORD, and beside your gifts, and beside all your vows, and beside all your freewill offerings, which ye give unto the LORD.

[Lev 24:8](#) Every sabbath [H7676](#) he shall set it in order before the LORD continually, *being taken* from the children of Israel by an everlasting covenant.

[Lev 25:2](#) Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye come into the land which I give you, then shall the land keep a sabbath [H7676](#) unto the LORD.

[Lev 25:4](#) But in the seventh year shall be a sabbath [H7676](#) of rest unto the land, a sabbath [H7676](#) for the LORD: thou shalt neither sow thy field, nor prune thy vineyard.

[Lev 25:6](#) And the sabbath [H7676](#) of the land shall be meat for you; for thee, and for thy servant, and for thy maid, and for thy hired servant, and for thy stranger that sojourneth with thee,

[Lev 25:8](#) And thou shalt number seven sabbaths [H7676](#) of years unto thee, seven times seven years; and the space of the seven sabbaths [H7676](#) of years shall be unto thee forty and nine years.

[Lev 26:2](#) Ye shall keep my sabbaths, [H7676](#) and reverence my sanctuary: I *am* the LORD.

[Lev 26:34](#) Then shall the land enjoy her sabbaths, [H7676](#) as long as it lieth desolate, and ye *be* in your enemies' land; *even* then shall the land rest, and enjoy her sabbaths. [H7676](#)

[Lev 26:35](#) As long as it lieth desolate it shall rest; because it did not rest in your sabbaths, [H7676](#) when ye dwelt upon it.

[Lev 26:43](#) The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, [H7676](#) while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised my judgments, and because their soul abhorred my statutes.

[Num 15:32](#) And while the children of Israel were in the wilderness, they found a man that gathered sticks upon the sabbath [H7676](#) day.

[Num 28:9](#) And on the sabbath [H7676](#) day two lambs of the first year without spot, and two tenth deals of flour *for* a meat offering, mingled with oil, and the drink offering thereof:

[Num 28:10](#) *This is* the burnt offering of every sabbath, [H7676](#) beside the continual burnt offering, and his drink offering.

[Deu 5:12](#) Keep the sabbath [H7676](#) day to sanctify it, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee.

[Deu 5:14](#) But the seventh day *is* the sabbath [H7676](#) of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thine ox, nor thine ass, nor any of thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates; that thy manservant and thy maidservant may rest as well as thou.

[Deu 5:15](#) And remember that thou wast a servant in the land of Egypt, and *that* the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: therefore the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath [H7676](#) day.

[2Ki](#) And he said, Wherefore wilt thou go to him to day? *it is* neither new moon, nor

[4:23](#) sabbath. [H7676](#) And she said, *It shall be* well.

[2Ki](#) And he commanded them, saying, This *is* the thing that ye shall do; A third part of you

[11:5](#) that enter in on the sabbath [H7676](#) shall even be keepers of the watch of the king's house;

[2Ki](#) And two parts of all you that go forth on the sabbath, [H7676](#) even they shall keep the watch

[11:7](#) of the house of the LORD about the king.

[2Ki](#) And the captains over the hundreds did according to all *things* that Jehoiada the priest

[11:9](#) commanded: and they took every man his men that were to come in on the sabbath, [H7676](#)

with them that should go out on the sabbath, [H7676](#) and came to Jehoiada the priest.

[2Ki](#) And the covert for the sabbath [H7676](#) that they had built in the house, and the king's entry

[16:18](#) without, turned he from the house of the LORD for the king of Assyria.

[1Ch](#) And *other* of their brethren, of the sons of the Kohathites, *were* over the shewbread, to

[9:32](#) prepare *it* every sabbath. [H7676](#)

[1Ch](#) And to offer all burnt sacrifices unto the LORD in the sabbaths, [H7676](#) in the new moons,

[23:31](#) and on the set feasts, by number, according to the order commanded unto them,

continually before the LORD:

[2Ch](#) Behold, I build an house to the name of the LORD my God, to dedicate *it* to him, *and* to

[2:4](#) burn before him sweet incense, and for the continual shewbread, and for the burnt

offerings morning and evening, on the sabbaths, [H7676](#) and on the new moons, and on the

solemn feasts of the LORD our God. This *is an ordinance* for ever to Israel.

[2Ch](#) Even after a certain rate every day, offering according to the commandment of Moses, on

[8:13](#) the sabbaths, [H7676](#) and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts, three times in the

year, *even* in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of

tabernacles.

[2Ch](#) This *is* the thing that ye shall do; A third part of you entering on the sabbath, [H7676](#) of the

[23:4](#) priests and of the Levites, *shall be* porters of the doors;

[2Ch](#) So the Levites and all Judah did according to all things that Jehoiada the priest had

[23:8](#) commanded, and took every man his men that were to come in on the sabbath, [H7676](#) with

them that were to go *out* on the sabbath: [H7676](#) for Jehoiada the priest dismissed not the

courses.

[2Ch](#) *He appointed* also the king's portion of his substance for the burnt offerings, *to wit*, for the

[31:3](#) morning and evening burnt offerings, and the burnt offerings for the sabbaths, [H7676](#) and

for the new moons, and for the set feasts, as *it is* written in the law of the LORD.

[2Ch](#) To fulfil the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had enjoyed her

[36:21](#) sabbaths: [H7676](#) *for* as long as she lay desolate she kept sabbath, to fulfil threescore and ten

years.

[Neh](#) And madest known unto them thy holy sabbath, [H7676](#) and commandedst them precepts,

[9:14](#) statutes, and laws, by the hand of Moses thy servant:

[Neh](#) And *if* the people of the land bring ware or any victuals on the sabbath [H7676](#) day to sell,

[10:31](#) *that* we would not buy it of them on the sabbath, [H7676](#) or on the holy day: and *that* we

would leave the seventh year, and the exaction of every debt.

[Neh](#) For the shewbread, and for the continual meat offering, and for the continual burnt

[10:33](#) offering, of the sabbaths, [H7676](#) of the new moons, for the set feasts, and for the holy

things, and for the sin offerings to make an atonement for Israel, and *for* all the work of

the house of our God.

[Neh](#) In those days saw I in Judah *some* treading wine presses on the sabbath, [H7676](#) and bringing

[13:15](#) in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all *manner of* burdens,

which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath [H7676](#) day: and I testified *against them* in the day wherein they sold victuals.

[Neh 13:16](#) There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the sabbath [H7676](#) unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

[Neh 13:17](#) Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing *is* this that ye do, and profane the sabbath [H7676](#) day?

[Neh 13:18](#) Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? yet ye bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the sabbath. [H7676](#)

[Neh 13:19](#) And it came to pass, that when the gates of Jerusalem began to be dark before the sabbath, [H7676](#) I commanded that the gates should be shut, and charged that they should not be opened till after the sabbath: [H7676](#) and *some* of my servants set I at the gates, *that* there should no burden be brought in on the sabbath [H7676](#) day.

[Neh 13:21](#) Then I testified against them, and said unto them, Why lodge ye about the wall? if ye do *so* again, I will lay hands on you. From that time forth came they no *more* on the sabbath. [H7676](#)

[Neh 13:22](#) And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and *that* they should come *and* keep the gates, to sanctify the sabbath [H7676](#) day. Remember me, O my God, *concerning* this also, and spare me according to the greatness of thy mercy.

[Psa 92:1](#) [[A Psalm *or* Song for the sabbath [H7676](#) day.]] *It is a good thing* to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:

[Isa 1:13](#) Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an abomination unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, [H7676](#) the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; *it is* iniquity, even the solemn meeting.

[Isa 56:2](#) Blessed *is* the man *that* doeth this, and the son of man *that* layeth hold on it; that keepeth the sabbath [H7676](#) from polluting it, and keepeth his hand from doing any evil.

[Isa 56:4](#) For thus saith the LORD unto the eunuchs that keep my sabbaths, [H7676](#) and choose *the things* that please me, and take hold of my covenant;

[Isa 56:6](#) Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the LORD, to serve him, and to love the name of the LORD, to be his servants, every one that keepeth the sabbath [H7676](#) from polluting it, and taketh hold of my covenant;

[Isa 58:13](#) If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, [H7676](#) *from* doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath [H7676](#) a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking *thine own* words:

[Isa 66:23](#) And it shall come to pass, *that* from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath [H7676](#) to another, [H7676](#) shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD.

[Jer 17:21](#) Thus saith the LORD; Take heed to yourselves, and bear no burden on the sabbath [H7676](#) day, nor bring *it* in by the gates of Jerusalem;

[Jer 17:22](#) Neither carry forth a burden out of your houses on the sabbath [H7676](#) day, neither do ye any work, but hallow ye the sabbath [H7676](#) day, as I commanded your fathers.

[Jer 17:24](#) And it shall come to pass, if ye diligently hearken unto me, saith the LORD, to bring in no burden through the gates of this city on the sabbath [H7676](#) day, but hallow the sabbath [H7676](#) day, to do no work therein;

[Jer 17:27](#) But if ye will not hearken unto me to hallow the sabbath [H7676](#) day, and not to bear a burden, even entering in at the gates of Jerusalem on the sabbath [H7676](#) day; then will I kindle a fire in the gates thereof, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall

not be quenched.

[Lam 2:6](#) And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as *if it were of a garden*: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths [H7676](#) to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest.

[Eze 20:12](#) Moreover also I gave them my sabbaths, [H7676](#) to be a sign between me and them, that they might know that I *am* the LORD that sanctify them.

[Eze 20:13](#) But the house of Israel rebelled against me in the wilderness: they walked not in my statutes, and they despised my judgments, which *if a man do*, he shall even live in them; and my sabbaths [H7676](#) they greatly polluted: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, to consume them.

[Eze 20:16](#) Because they despised my judgments, and walked not in my statutes, but polluted my sabbaths: [H7676](#) for their heart went after their idols.

[Eze 20:20](#) And hallow my sabbaths; [H7676](#) and they shall be a sign between me and you, that ye may know that I *am* the LORD your God.

[Eze 20:21](#) Notwithstanding the children rebelled against me: they walked not in my statutes, neither kept my judgments to do them, which *if a man do*, he shall even live in them; they polluted my sabbaths: [H7676](#) then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the wilderness.

[Eze 20:24](#) Because they had not executed my judgments, but had despised my statutes, and had polluted my sabbaths, [H7676](#) and their eyes were after their fathers' idols.

[Eze 22:8](#) Thou hast despised mine holy things, and hast profaned my sabbaths. [H7676](#)

[Eze 22:26](#) Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they shewed *difference* between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, [H7676](#) and I am profaned among them.

[Eze 23:38](#) Moreover this they have done unto me: they have defiled my sanctuary in the same day, and have profaned my sabbaths. [H7676](#)

[Eze 44:24](#) And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; *and* they shall judge it according to my judgments: and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in all mine assemblies; and they shall hallow my sabbaths. [H7676](#)

[Eze 45:17](#) And it shall be the prince's part *to give* burnt offerings, and meat offerings, and drink offerings, in the feasts, and in the new moons, and in the sabbaths, [H7676](#) in all solemnities of the house of Israel: he shall prepare the sin offering, and the meat offering, and the burnt offering, and the peace offerings, to make reconciliation for the house of Israel.

[Eze 46:1](#) Thus saith the Lord GOD; The gate of the inner court that looketh toward the east shall be shut the six working days; but on the sabbath [H7676](#) it shall be opened, and in the day of the new moon it shall be opened.

[Eze 46:3](#) Likewise the people of the land shall worship at the door of this gate before the LORD in the sabbaths [H7676](#) and in the new moons.

[Eze 46:4](#) And the burnt offering that the prince shall offer unto the LORD in the sabbath [H7676](#) day *shall be* six lambs without blemish, and a ram without blemish.

[Eze 46:12](#) Now when the prince shall prepare a voluntary burnt offering or peace offerings voluntarily unto the LORD, *one* shall then open him the gate that looketh toward the east, and he shall prepare his burnt offering and his peace offerings, as he did on the

sabbath [H7676](#) day: then he shall go forth; and after his going forth *one* shall shut the gate. [Hos 2:11](#) I will also cause all her mirth to cease, her feast days, her new moons, and her sabbaths, [H7676](#) and all her solemn feasts. [Amo 8:5](#) Saying, When will the new moon be gone, that we may sell corn? and the sabbath, [H7676](#) that we may set forth wheat, making the ephah small, and the shekel great, and falsifying the balances by deceit?

Strong's Number **G4521** matches the Greek **σάββατον** (*sabbaton*), which occurs 68 times in **62** verses in the Greek concordance of the KJV

[Mat 12:1](#) At that time Jesus went on the sabbath day [G4521](#) through the corn; and his disciples were an hungred, and began to pluck the ears of corn, and to eat.

[Mat 12:2](#) But when the Pharisees saw *it*, they said unto him, Behold, thy disciples do that which is not lawful to do upon the sabbath day. [G4521](#)

[Mat 12:5](#) Or have ye not read in the law, how that on the sabbath days [G4521](#) the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, [G4521](#) and are blameless?

[Mat 12:8](#) For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day. [G4521](#)

[Mat 12:10](#) And, behold, there was a man which had *his* hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? [G4521](#) that they might accuse him.

[Mat 12:11](#) And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, [G4521](#) will he not lay hold on it, and lift *it* out?

[Mat 12:12](#) How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days. [G4521](#)

[Mat 24:20](#) But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day: [G4521](#)

[Mat 28:1](#) In the end of the sabbath, [G4521](#) as it began to dawn toward the first *day* of the week, [G4521](#) came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

[Mar 1:21](#) And they went into Capernaum; and straightway on the sabbath day [G4521](#) he entered into the synagogue, and taught.

[Mar 2:23](#) And it came to pass, that he went through the corn fields on the sabbath day; [G4521](#) and his disciples began, as they went, to pluck the ears of corn.

[Mar 2:24](#) And the Pharisees said unto him, Behold, why do they on the sabbath day [G4521](#) that which is not lawful?

[Mar 2:27](#) And he said unto them, The sabbath [G4521](#) was made for man, and not man for the sabbath: [G4521](#)

[Mar 2:28](#) Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath. [G4521](#)

[Mar 3:2](#) And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day; [G4521](#) that they might accuse him.

[Mar 3:4](#) And he saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, [G4521](#) or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace.

[Mar 6:2](#) And when the sabbath day [G4521](#) was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing *him* were astonished, saying, From whence hath this *man* these things? and what wisdom *is* this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?

[Mar 16:1](#) And when the sabbath [G4521](#) was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the *mother* of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him.

[Mar 16:2](#) And very early in the morning the first *day* of the week, [G4521](#) they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun.

[Mar 16:9](#) Now when *Jesus* was risen early the first *day* of the week, [G4521](#) he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.

[Luk 4:16](#) And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath [G4521](#) day, and stood up for to read.

[Luk 4:31](#) And came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath days. [G4521](#)

[Luk 6:1](#) And it came to pass on the second sabbath [G4521](#) after the first, that he went through the corn fields; and his disciples plucked the ears of corn, and did eat, rubbing *them* in *their* hands.

[Luk 6:2](#) And certain of the Pharisees said unto them, Why do ye that which is not lawful to do on the sabbath days? [G4521](#)

[Luk 6:5](#) And he said unto them, That the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath. [G4521](#)

[Luk 6:6](#) And it came to pass also on another sabbath, [G4521](#) that he entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered.

[Luk 6:7](#) And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal on the sabbath day; [G4521](#) that they might find an accusation against him.

[Luk 6:9](#) Then said Jesus unto them, I will ask you one thing; Is it lawful on the sabbath days [G4521](#) to do good, or to do evil? to save life, or to destroy *it*?

[Luk 13:10](#) And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath. [G4521](#)

[Luk 13:14](#) And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath [G4521](#) day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath [G4521](#) day.

[Luk 13:15](#) The Lord then answered him, and said, *Thou* hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath [G4521](#) loose his ox or *his* ass from the stall, and lead *him* away to watering?

[Luk 13:16](#) And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath [G4521](#) day?

[Luk 14:1](#) And it came to pass, as he went into the house of one of the chief Pharisees to eat bread on the sabbath [G4521](#) day, that they watched him.

[Luk 14:3](#) And Jesus answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath day? [G4521](#)

[Luk 14:5](#) And answered them, saying, Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit, and will not straightway pull him out on the sabbath [G4521](#) day?

[Luk 18:12](#) I fast twice in the week, [G4521](#) I give tithes of all that I possess.

[Luk 23:54](#) And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath [G4521](#) drew on.

[Luk 23:56](#) And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day [G4521](#) according to the commandment.

[Luk 24:1](#) Now upon the first *day* of the week, [G4521](#) very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain *others* with them.

[Jhn 5:9](#) And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath. [G4521](#)

[Jhn 5:10](#) The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured, It is the sabbath day: [G4521](#) it is not lawful for thee to carry *thy* bed.

[Jhn 5:16](#) And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day. [G4521](#)

[Jhn 5:18](#) Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, [G4521](#) but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.

[Jhn 7:22](#) Moses therefore gave unto you circumcision; (not because it is of Moses, but of the fathers;) and ye on the sabbath day [G4521](#) circumcise a man.

[Jhn 7:23](#) If a man on the sabbath day [G4521](#) receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day? [G4521](#)

[Jhn 9:14](#) And it was the sabbath day [G4521](#) when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.

[Jhn 9:16](#) Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. [G4521](#) Others said, How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles? And there was a division among them.

[Jhn 19:31](#) The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, [G4521](#) (for that sabbath day [G4521](#) was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and *that* they might be taken away.

[Jhn 20:1](#) The first *day* of the week [G4521](#) cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

[Jhn 20:19](#) Then the same day at evening, being the first *day* of the week, [G4521](#) when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace *be* unto you.

[Act 1:12](#) Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath [G4521](#) day's journey.

[Act 13:14](#) But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and went into the synagogue on the sabbath [G4521](#) day, and sat down.

[Act 13:27](#) For they that dwell at Jerusalem, and their rulers, because they knew him not, nor yet the voices of the prophets which are read every sabbath day, [G4521](#) they have fulfilled *them* in condemning *him*.

[Act 13:42](#) And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them the next sabbath. [G4521](#)

[Act 13:44](#) And the next sabbath day [G4521](#) came almost the whole city together to hear the word of God.

[Act 15:21](#) For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day. [G4521](#)

[Act 16:13](#) And on the sabbath [G4521](#) we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted *thither*.

[Act 17:2](#) And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three sabbath [G4521](#) days reasoned with them out of the scriptures,

[Act 18:4](#) And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, [G4521](#) and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.

[Act](#) And upon the first *day* of the week, [G4521](#) when the disciples came together to break bread,

[20:7](#) Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight.

[1Co](#) Upon the first *day* of the week [G4521](#) let every one of you lay by him in store, as *God* hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.

[Col](#) Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath [G4521](#) *days*:
