- Jhn If a man on the sabbath day G4521 receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not
- 7:23 be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day? G4521
- Jhn And it was the sabbath day ^{G4521} when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.
- <u>9:14</u>
- Jhn Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the
- 9:16 sabbath day. G4521 Others said, How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles? And there was a division among them.
- Jhn The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain
- 19:31 upon the cross on the sabbath day, G4521 (for that sabbath day G4521 was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and *that* they might be taken away.
- <u>Jhn</u> The first day of the week $\frac{G4521}{}$ cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto
- 20:1 the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.
- <u>Jhn</u> Then the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, $\frac{G4521}{}$ when the doors were
- 20:19 shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace *be* unto you.
- Act Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem
- 1:12 a sabbath G4521 day's journey.
- Act But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and went into the
- 13:14 synagogue on the sabbath 64521 day, and sat down.
- Act For they that dwell at Jerusalem, and their rulers, because they knew him not, nor yet the
- 13:27 voices of the prophets which are read every sabbath day, G4521 they have fulfilled *them* in condemning *him*.
- Act And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these
- 13:42 words might be preached to them the next sabbath. G4521
- Act And the next sabbath day 64521 came almost the whole city together to hear the word of
- 13:44 God.
- Act For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the
- 15:21 synagogues every sabbath day. G4521
- Act And on the sabbath 64521 we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to
- 16:13 be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted thither.
- Act And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three sabbath 64521 days reasoned
- 17:2 with them out of the scriptures,
- Act And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, G4521 and persuaded the Jews and the
- 18:4 Greeks.
- Act And upon the first day of the week, $\frac{G4521}{}$ when the disciples came together to break bread,

- 20:7 Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight.
- 1Co Upon the first day of the week G4521 let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath
- prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.
- Col Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the
- 2:16 new moon, or of the sabbath G4521 days:
