

## Eschatology 101

“And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, **for** He will save His people from their sins.” Matthew 1:21 (emphasis added). Jesus = Yeshua = Salvation

First 2 Days of Creation => First 2000 Years → Tohu (Days of Desolation or Chaos)  
Second 2 Days of Creation => Second 2000 Years → Torah (Days of God’s Instructions)  
Third 2 Days of Creation => Third 3000 Years → Maschiach (Days of Messiah)  
Seventh Day of Creation => Final 1000 Years → Atid Lavo (What is to Come / Messianic Kingdom)

Scripture references: Psalm 90:4, 2 Peter 3:8; Hosea 5:14 – 6:2

Mo’edim (Appointments of God) are found in Leviticus 23.

Spring Mo’edim teach the first coming of Yeshua (March to April, then June)

1. Passover (14<sup>th</sup> day of 1<sup>st</sup> month) → Death of Messiah by crucifixion
2. Unleavened Bread (begins 15<sup>th</sup> day of 1<sup>st</sup> month) [High Sabbath] → Burial of Messiah
3. First Fruits (Day after Sabbath during week of Unleavened Bread) → Resurrection
4. Weeks / Shavuot / Pentecost (50 days after Sabbath above) → Holy Spirit [Acts 2]

Fall Mo’edim teach the second coming of Yeshua (September to October)

5. Rosh Hashanah / Yom Teruah (1<sup>st</sup> day of 7<sup>th</sup> month) → Rapture and Resurrection
  6. Yom Kippur / Day of Atonement (10<sup>th</sup> day of 7<sup>th</sup> month) → Sets His feet on Mt of Olives [Ezekiel 43; Zechariah 14; Revelation 19]
  7. Sukkoth / Tabernacles / Booths (15<sup>th</sup> day of 7<sup>th</sup> month) → Establishes the Messianic Kingdom

Passover Week in year of Messiah’s Death

1<sup>st</sup> day of week (Sunday) → Palm Sunday; Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> days → Examined by every group (Pharisees, Sadducees, Romans, etc.); no sin

5<sup>th</sup> day of week (Thursday) → Nailed to tree at 9 a.m., died at 3 p.m. just like lamb for Israel

5<sup>th</sup> day of week (Thursday) → Buried just before/as the sun sets to begin 6<sup>th</sup> day of week

[See John 19:31, “(for that Sabbath was a high day)” means the High Sabbath not weekly Sabbath

7<sup>th</sup> day of week (Saturday) → Sabbath, no work

1<sup>st</sup> day of next week (Sunday) → Yeshua arises on Feast of First Fruits [1 Cor. 15:20, 23]
