

Come Out and Be Separate

1. Separate from the world

- **2 Corinthians 6:17**—"Come out" G1831-exerchomai (ex-AIR-cho-my)
 - **Revelation 18:4**

2. We are commanded to be holy, or separate

New Testament→G40-hagios

- **Romans 12:1-2**—living sacrifice-sacrifices had to be spotless and without blemish (**Malachi 1:6-14**). This is how we are to live our lives→**Matthew 5:48**. V.2—"conformed" G4964-syschematizo (su-schem-uh-TEED-zo)→Used also in **1 Peter 1:14**. **Romans 7:12**—we are to live a holy life because the Law is holy.
- **1 Corinthians 1:2**—called to be saints, or literally, "holy ones"→**Revelation 12:17** and **14:12**—what characterizes a "saint"?
 - **1 Corinthians 3:17**—"defile" G5351-phtheiro-equal to שחת
Exodus 32:7-8, 33; Deuteronomy 32:5-6; Lamentations 2:5-6
 - **Ephesians 2:21**—read v. 19-22
 - **Ephesians 5:3**—read v. 1-7
 - **Colossians 1:22**—read v. 21-23
 - **Colossians 3:12**—read v. 1-17; In v. 1-11, Paul is telling people to stop acting like the world.
 - **2 Thessalonians 1:10**—read v. 3-12
 - **1 Peter 1: 15-16**—read v. 10-16; v. 15→ anastrophe G391—walk; v. 16→**Leviticus 11:44-45; 19:2; 20:7**
 - **1 Peter 2:9**
 - **2 Peter 2:21**—read v. 20-22- the holy commandment is supposed to help His people live uprightly before Him.
 - **2 Peter 3:11**—Because of the coming Day of Judgment, how should we live?
 - **Revelation 4:8**—Same cry as Isaiah 6:3
 - **Revelation 20:6**—He who is holy gets to take part in the first resurrection.

Old Testament→H6918-kadosh

- Gesenius' Hebrew-Chaldee Lexicon: "Pure, clean, free from defilement of crimes, idolatry, and other **unclean** and profane things."
 - 1st use—**Exodus 19:6**

- **Leviticus 11:44-45**—concerning unclean foods
 - **Leviticus 19:2**—the very next verse is about remembering His Sabbaths
 - **Leviticus 20:7, 26**—this section is all about seeking mediums, sexual immorality, and unclean food.
 - **Numbers 15:40**—Read v. 37-41. The purpose of the tzitzit
 - **Deuteronomy 7:6**—Read through v. 11. How do the people show they are holy?
 - **Deuteronomy 14:2**—the very next section discusses unclean food...again.
 - **Deuteronomy 26:19**—read v. 16-19
 - **2 Kings 4:9**—what set Elisha apart that showed he was “holy”?
 - **Psalm 16:3**—contrast to v. 4
 - **Psalm 89:7**—the assembly of the saints is all those who are around Him
- 3. *Separate from false teaching***
- **Acts 4:8-22**—v. 19—do we obey men or God?
 - **2 Timothy 2:15-19**—v.16→“idle babblings” G2757—kenoponia (ke-no-pho-NEE-uh)—babbling, empty discussion—**1 Timothy 6:20**; v.19→“depart” G868—aphistemi (uh-PHIS-tay-me)—flee, withdraw, revolt—**Luke 13:27**; **1 Timothy 4:1**; **1 Timothy 6:1-10 (v.5)**; **Hebrew 3:7-15 (v.12)**
 - **2 Timothy 3:1-7**—we are to turn away from the people characterized in this list.
 - **1 Corinthians 15:29-34**—if the resurrection didn’t happen, why am I risking my life for it? V.33→**Proverbs 13:20**. V.34→“awake” G1594—eknepho (ek-NAY-pho)—return to one’s self from drunkenness and become sober.
 - **Matthew 7:13-23**—There are only two paths—broad and narrow
 - **Lamentations 2:14**—How did the false prophets affect the people? They continued in their sins.
 - **Psalm 119:104**—read entire “mem” section
 - **2 Corinthians 11:14**—Read v. 12-15. “Light” refers to truth→“messenger of truth”
 - **1 Peter 5: 8-11**—Resist the devil and the ways of the world. Yes, you will suffer persecution for choosing to live against the world and for God.
 - **James 4:1-10**—You can’t be a friend to the world and expect to please God. V.4—**Ephesians 4:17-24**.
 - **2 Timothy 3:10-4:5**—Perfectly describes what is happening here in the last days
 - **Revelation 3:14-21**—The LORD calls us to choose, not falter between two opinions→**1 Kings 18:20-21**; **Deuteronomy 30:11-20**; **Joshua 24: 14-15**
