


The Millennial Kingdom and the New Heavens and New Earth


Timing: 7th Millennium: The Tribulation Period/The Millennial Kingdom→1 Thessalonians 5:1-4



I. The Timing of the Tribulation Period: 2,520 days, or 7 years (360 days per year)

1,260 days: Seal and Trumpet Judgements

1,260 days: Great Tribulation; Bowl Judgements



- Rapture→ **Revelation 4:1**—"Door (gate) standing open in heaven"—Reference to Yom Teruah; **1 Corinthians 15:52**—"last trump"—Another reference to Yom Teruah; **1 Thessalonians 4:15-18**
- How do we know the tribulation period is two sets of 1,260 days?
 - First 1,260 days→**Revelation 11:3, 7-9**—If this is the end of the Tribulation, then all of the wicked sinners would be killed, not rejoicing over the dead bodies of the two witnesses. This has to be in the first 1,260 days.
 - Second 1,260 days→**Revelation 12:13-17**—v.14: time, times, and half a time (3 ½ years) and v.6: 1,260 days.
- Psalm 83 war→ **Psalm 83:1-18**
- False Messiah confirms covenant→ **Daniel 9:27**
- Gog and Magog→ **Ezekiel 38:1-8, 23** (Nations→Magog-Russia ; Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal-Old Soviet nations, Ukraine, and "Stan" nations ; Sheba and Dedan- In the Arabian peninsula, includes United Arab Emirates; Tarshish-Spain)
- Believers flee Jerusalem→ **Matthew 24:15-22 ; Daniel 12:11**
- Satan kicked out of Heaven→ **Revelation 12:13-17**
- Battle of Armageddon→ **Revelation 16:12-16; 19:11-21**

II. What will the Day of the LORD be like?

- "Day of the LORD"—Is it one day? **2 Peter 3:8**
 - Amos 5:18-24**→The Day of the LORD is not a day that should be desired by the sinner.
 - Ezekiel 30:3**→This is the "time of the Gentiles"—**Romans 11:25, Revelation 11:2, Daniel 2:44-45**
 - Zephaniah 1:14-16**→It is a day of wrath against those who put their faith in everything but God.
 - Joel 3:14-16**→"Decision"—charuts 2742—Can be translated as threshing instrument. This takes place at the end of the Tribulation.
 - Zechariah 14:1**→Jerusalem is invaded, but the believers have already fled to Petra. V.5—The LORD returns for Armageddon. This takes place around the end of the Tribulation.
 - Zephaniah 2:1-3**→The LORD's anger is not poured out on the meek of the earth. They are hidden at the beginning of the Tribulation.
 - Jeremiah 46:10**→This is the day of vengeance where the LORD avenges Himself on His adversaries. This helps to answer the question, "How long?"
 - Joel 2:1**→The trumpet that signals the Rapture is blown at the beginning of the Day of the LORD.

- i. **2 Peter 3:10**→The heavens and earth are cleansed with fire at the end of the thousand years. This is still considered the Day of the LORD. It is the transition point between the Day of the LORD and the New Heavens and the New Earth.
- j. **1 Corinthians 5:5**→Notice the day is called the Day of the LORD Yeshua?
- k. **Revelation 1:10**→John was in the spirit concerning the Day of the LORD. This is not a code word for Sunday.

2. “End of Days”

- a. End of days
 - Mostly translated as “days to come” or “last days”. Hebrew: acharit hayamim→ acharit-“end”; hayamim-“the days”
 - From Brown-Driver-Briggs Lexicon on acharit hayamim: “A prophetic phrase denoting the final period of the history so far as the speaker’s perspective reaches” speaking of the “Messianic future”.
- b. **Deuteronomy 31:29** and **4:30**→Israel will face trouble in the end of days, but the believing remnant will repent.
- c. **Micah 4:1-4**→The kingdom will be established in the end of days after the Tribulation.
- d. **Ezekiel 38:16**→This battle happens in the Tribulation so that all of the nations will know He is the LORD.
- e. **Daniel 8:19-26**→v.19—“latter time of the indignation”—acharit za’am—end of the Tribulation
- f. **Hosea 3:5**→They won’t have a place to worship God or the pagan deities. “Teraphim”—used in pagan worship.

3. “In that day...”

- a. **Exodus 13:8**→Unleavened Bread will be kept into the kingdom.
- b. **Isaiah 24:21-23**→This refers to the battle of Armageddon.
- c. **Isaiah 26:1-2, 8, 19-21; 27:1, 12-13**→26:2—Refers to Yom Teruah; 27:13—“Great trumpet”—Yom Kippur
- d. **Isaiah 29:18**→Refer back to v.11-12
- e. **Jeremiah 25:33**→**Revelation 14:20; 19:17-18**
- f. **Ezekiel 38:10, 14, 18, 19**→Read v. 10-23; v.18—“at the same time”—in that day
- g. **Amos 9:11, 13**→Read v.11-15; “The days are coming”—Time leading up to Day of the LORD and following
- h. **Zephaniah 3:11**→Read v.8-13; only the meek and humble will inherit the kingdom
- i. **Zechariah 2:11**→Read v.10-13; Many nations will serve the LORD in the kingdom
- j. **Zechariah 12: 3, 4, 6, 8**→Read v.1-9; The land will be inhabited in its own place.

4. The Millennial Kingdom in the Psalms

- a. **Psalms 15**→Who can make it into the kingdom?
- b. **Psalms 25:12-15**→The one who fears the LORD will inherit the earth with his descendants.
- c. **Psalms 34:11-16**→The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, but the wicked are cut off from the earth.
- d. **Psalms 89:3-4, 28-29, 36-37**→The throne of David shall continue forever.
- e. **Psalms 100:5**→Hebrew—“v’ad dor v’dor emunato”. Literally—“And until a generation and a generation is His truth”. So, His truth is from generation to generation. It never ends.
- f. **Psalms 110**→Judgement belongs to Yeshua.

8th Millennium into Eternity: The New Heavens and the New Earth

- I. End of Millennial Kingdom: **Revelation 20: 7-15**
 - Satan raises up army to overthrow Messiah; he is cast into the lake of fire.
 - Unbelievers stand the Great White Throne Judgement, and cast into the lake of fire.
 - No more sin and death.
- II. “The New Heavens and the New Earth”
 - **Isaiah 65: 17-19**→Connects directly to Revelation 21:1-4
 - **Revelation 21:1-4**→The LORD will tabernacle with men.
 - **Isaiah 66: 22-24**→Israel will continue on into the kingdom.
 - **2 Peter 3: 10-18**→Live righteously and don’t listen to false teachers, but grow in knowledge of the LORD.
