

Biblical Notations on Forever

Genesis 9:12-16 Rainbow perpetual sign of covenant.

Genesis 17:7,13,19 Covenant is everlasting.

Exodus 12:18-24 Passover

Exodus 20: 8-11 People and animals to keep Sabbath.

Exodus 27:20-21 Pure olive oil for lamp outside the veil in temple.

Exodus 28:43 Priests wear linen trousers when serving in temple.

Exodus 29:27-28 Heave/wave offering breast and thigh for Aaron and his sons.

Exodus 30:17-21 Aaron and his sons wash hands and feet before enter temple and come near the altar.

Exodus 31:12-17 Keep Sabbath.

Leviticus 6:18 All the males of the children of Aaron may eat of the unleavened bread made from grain offering.

Leviticus 6:19-22 Offering of flour by anointed priest.

Leviticus 7:34 & 36 Heave/wave offering breast and thigh for Aaron and his sons.

Leviticus 10:9 Drink no wine when burning incense.

Leviticus 10:15 Aaron and his sons eat from peace offerings.

Leviticus 16:29 Yom Kippur Tishri 10 afflict soul and do no work at all.

Leviticus 17:1-7 Sacrifice only at the altar.

Leviticus 17:13 Prohibits eating blood.

Leviticus 23:14 Offering to God before eating newly harvested grain.

Leviticus 23:21 Holy convocation on Feast of Weeks/Pentecost

Leviticus 23:31 Yom Kippur/Day of Atonement

Leviticus 23:41 Feast of Tabernacles/Sukkot

Leviticus 24:3 Pure olive oil for lamp outside the veil in temple.

Numbers 15:15-16 One law and custom for all.

Numbers 18:8-11,19 Heave offerings.

Numbers 18:23-24 Levites have no inheritance as tithes and offerings of Israel are for their inheritance.

Numbers 19: 10 One who gathers ashes of red heifer is unclean until evening.

Ezekiel 36:22-32 Tells how Israel will be sprinkled with water of ash of red heifer.

Deuteronomy 5:10 Showing mercy to thousands [of generations] who love Me and keep My commandments

Deuteronomy 5:29 Keep commandments and will go well forever.

Deuteronomy 12:28 -32 Observe and do all commandments. Do not add to or take away from commandments.

Deuteronomy 28:45-46 Curses come from not doing commandments and statutes.

Deuteronomy 29:29 Do all the words of the law.

Joshua 4:19 -24 Fear the Lord.

2 Samuel 23:5 Everlasting covenant with David.

2 Kings 17:37 Keep commandments, statutes, ordinances and law forever.

1 Chronicles 16:15 Remember His covenant and commandments. For 1000 generations. V17 Everlasting covenant with Israel.

2 Chronicles 2:4 Sweet offerings.

Psalms 19:7-9 Fear of the Lord.

Psalm 105:8-10 Remembers covenant for 1000 generations.

Psalm 111:9 Covenant forever.

Psalm 119:44 Law forever and ever.

Psalm 119:89-98 Word is settled in heaven forever.

Psalm 119:105-112 Keep commandments, statutes, ordinances and law forever.

Psalm 119:160 Entirety of word is truth, judgements are forever.

Proverbs 28:9 One who turns his ear from hearing the law, Even his prayer is an abomination.

Isaiah 2:2-3 Out of Zion the law will go forth in the latter days [the End of Days].

Isaiah 24:4-6 Defiled by transgressing law.

Isaiah 55:3 Everlasting covenant who incline ear and Hear/obey.

Isaiah 56:1-7 Everyone to keep Sabbath.

Isaiah 59:20-21 My words shall not depart from your mouth.

Isaiah 61:8 Everlasting covenant.

Isaiah 66:14-17 Those eating swine's flesh and abomination are burned up.

Isaiah 66:22-24 Keeping new moon and Sabbath in new heaven and earth.

Jeremiah 31:33 Put law in mind and write on hearts.

Jeremiah 32:37-40 Gathers Israel from countries where they were scattered keeping the everlasting covenant.

Ezekiel 16:60-63 Everlasting covenant.

Ezekiel 37:26-28 Everlasting covenant of peace

Ezekiel 43:18 - 46:24 Sacrifice and Sabbath.

Ezekiel 44:23-25 In the Messianic Kingdom priests teach law, statutes, clean and unclean, and keep Sabbaths.

Zechariah 14:16-21 Keeping Feast of Tabernacles/Sukkot and sacrificing.

Matthew 5:17-20 Nothing from the law will pass away until heaven and earth pass away and all has been fulfilled.

Matthew 7:21-23 Depart from Me you who practice lawlessness.

Luke 6:46 Why do you call me Lord, Lord and not do the things I say.

John 14:15 If you love Me keep my commandments.

Romans 3:20 Law brings knowledge of sin.

Romans 3:31 We do not make void the law by faith but establish it.

Galatians 3:5-9, 16-18 Only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham. Promise was made to Abraham and his Seed.

Hebrews 8:8-13 New covenant with house of Israel. Laws in mind and heart.

Hebrews 10:1-4 Sacrifices are reminder of sin.

Hebrews 10:16 Put law in hearts and minds.

Hebrews 13:20 Jesus' blood of the everlasting covenant.

1 Timothy 6:14 Keep His commandments without spot.

1 John 2:3-6 We know that we know Him if we keep His commandments.

1 John 3:4 Sin is lawlessness.

1 John 5:2-3 Love God and Keep His commandments.

Revelation 12:17 Keep the commandments of God and the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Revelation 14:6 Everlasting gospel
